## DEALING WITH PROBLEM ISSUES AND IRREGULARITIES

It is wise, in most cases, for a bishop to seek counsel when dealing with problem issues and irregularities in congregations. The following may be helpful:

- 1. Personal consultation with bishops or other spiritual leaders who have skills or experiences in working with the specific issue or irregularity.
- 2. Ask one or more bishops to assist in working with the congregation or individuals involved in the problem.
- 3. Share the problem with the Bishop Board and receive their counsel.
- 4. Ask the Bishop Board or the Executive Committee to assign several bishops to assist in working through the problem.
