Angelus: A Call to Prayer

October 2018

- 1. Pray for Alexander and Maria*, regional representatives for Central and South Asia, that they would know the Holy Spirit's presence, His grace, and His wisdom in their work and ministry each day.
- Please pray for the persons leading the Human Resources department at Landis Communities as they seek to fill openings with people who support the organization's guiding values and who can be "Jesus Christ in Street Clothes" to residents and clients.
- 3. Pray for LMC staff as they take the day to retreat together.
- 4. Pray for the Homecoming and Fall Festival this weekend at Lancaster Mennonite School. Pray for a good time of celebration, fun and catching up with former classmates, including reunions of the classes of 1958 and 1973. Give thanks for the many lives enriched by years spent at Lancaster Mennonite.
- 5. Praise God for his leading in search of Community Mennonite Fellowship in Milton's new Youth Ministries Director, Jim Hostetter.
- 6. Phil and Linda Gottschalk teach at Tyndale Theological Seminary, discipling the young people studying at the school. Pray for grace each day to teach and love these students.
- 7. Ask that God will open doors and hearts to receive Jesus, as Jonathan Bornman serves as a consultant for Christian-Muslim relations (Colossians 4:3).
- 8. Leon and Naomi Zimmerman are leadership trainers serving globally. Pray that God will make their ministry exceedingly fruitful, that He will be glorified through this ministry, and that the message of Jesus may spread rapidly and be honored (2 Thessalonians 3:1).

- 14. Pray for Mike and Roberta Lotvola, serving in Germany discipling young adults. Ask that God might give them energy and encouragement to pour into each of these young people.
