- 3. The Glen Lapp Memorial Volleyball tournament will be held at Lancaster Mennonite High School on January 5 and 12. Please pray for the tournament participants and also the family and friends of Glen Lapp as they celebrate his life and remember his commitment to service in the name of Christ.
- 4. Please pray for No Longer Alone Ministries' clients and their families as they struggle with depression and social anxiety during the holiday season.
- 5. Pray for Black Rock Retreat and all the New Year will bring. Also, pray for the following upcoming events: Jr. High Winter Camp Retreat, Summer Camp Open House and Silent Sanctuary Retreat.
- 6. Pray for the new pastor of Crossroads Mennonite Church and his family to find appropriate housing, and for the children's adaptation after moving from out of state. Pray for the congregation to embrace them with God's arms. Pray for the whole body to become one and prepare to move together in God's Spirit.
