

STEP provides three years of non-traditional ministry leadership training. Training occurs through online assignments and one class meeting per month, for nine months, for each of the three years. Students travel together through the three years in a cohort model.

Graduates earn 30 undergraduate credits from Eastern Mennonite University for completing the 3-year program, which functions as a guided practicum in ministry leadership based primarily on an action/reflection model of learning. LMC awards a certificate in Year 3.

Training in Ministry Program

This distance learning cooperative (CMC, LMC, RBC) ministry training program provides undergraduate level training in five different tracks: 1) congregational care and counseling; 2) spiritual and personal formation; 3) Bible and theology formation; 4) leadership and ministry formation; 5) church multiplication. Each 3-credit course runs for a 10-week term. September 2020 classes are "Discipling Others" and "Congregational Counseling."
