

Angelus: A Call to Prayer

3. Pray for Allen Eshleman in Guatemala as he begins his role as an LMC international partner delegate relating to the K'ekchi' Mennonite Church in Guatemala. Pray that he would soon be able to reschedule his trip to meet with the church leaders there to encourage them.
4. The Lord is working through the ministry of The Potter's House and House of Ruth. Please pray for financial blessings for the ministry.
5. Everyone at Lancaster Mennonite School is settling into the new school year amid uncertainty with COVID-19. Pray that this will be a year of growing and learning for students. Pray that faculty will have the wisdom, strength, calmness and patience that allows them to show Christ's love to their students as they teach and guide them.
6. Pray for the disciple-makers and church planters currently enrolled in Global Disciples' training programs. Pray that they would go forth in the power of the Holy Spirit to share the Gospel among the least-reached.
