- 3. Please pray for East Petersburg Mennonite Church and for their new pastor. Pray that the Lord will continue opening doors and closing gaps in their mission working together. Pray that the pastor will feel welcome in his new position.
- 4. Pray for the hispanic churches in the Dominican Republic Faro Divino as they plan for different activities and events for the whole congregation and their community.
- 5. Please pray for the staff and students at The Potter's House of Ruth Addiction Recovery and Discipleship Program. There is an immediate need for a resident house manager that has a heart to see transformation in the lives of struggling women.

- 10. Pray for the 50th Fellowship Day Auction and BBQ happening Saturday, Sept. 10 at Landis Homes. Money raised at this event goes to cover the full cost of care for residents who, through no fault of their own, have exhausted their financial resources.

Pray that the Lancaster Mennonite School community will continue to live with and find new ways to celebrate the theme for this year; 12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. <u>14</u> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
