1. *Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.* Roman 12:12.
2. Please lift up in prayer La Iglesia Casa de Oración in Wilmington, North Carolina, for their own building. The place where they are currently meeting does not allow them the freedom to function as a church. Please pray for a new building for them.
3. Pray for Mennonite Central Committee church partners in Egypt supporting displaced people with health support for young mothers, emergency food vouchers for those without income, and education opportunities for children.
4. 5-9 LMC & EMM Fasting and Prayer Week.
5. Please pray for LMC as they navigate organizational transitions. Ask the Lord to provide His light and wisdom to the organization as they adjust to these changes. We also ask for prayer for the Bishop Elder Team as they provide leadership during this time.
6. Please pray for those Hispanic churches that are being persecuted. Pray that the Lord will lift intercessors for the church in general and that the enemy will not have control on politics and let the Lord's church get closer to Him.
7. Praises from Peter Sensenig for his book tour in the United States was a success, with events in four states. He is happy to be back with his family. He and his family are also celebrating having had many positive interactions with Sudanese refugees in France.
8. Landis Communities turns 15 years old this year. Please pray for those who serve on the board of the organization as they give guidance and direction for the work of following God's call to creatively serve the diverse needs and interests of older adults by developing opportunities and collaborative relationships.
9. Join EMM in praising the Lord for the Southeast Asia team members, who are from all over the world, including Central and South America, Canada, and the U.S. Pray for them as they utilize the wide variety of skill sets that they possess in various countries, including Vietnam, Cambodia, and Thailand.
10. The 16th Annual Glen Lapp Memorial Volleyball tournament will be held at Lancaster Mennonite High School on January 10 and 11. Remember the tournament participants and also the family and friends of Glen Lapp (1987 LM Alum) as they celebrate his life and remember his commitment to service in the name of Christ.
11. Pray with EMM for the right individuals to join Jeremy and Jennifer's* ministry for displaced refugees in Thailand. Many people have crossed the border with Myanmar, escaping 80 years of civil war. Pray for the right partners to emerge as they provide holistic support to refugees that provides healing to their bodies, minds, and souls.
12. Pray for Joe and Yvonne as they have had their IPD trip rescheduled from December 2025 to January 13-26, 2026. Pray for the development of the schedule as conversations are taking place with the Tanzania Mennonite Church leadership. Our hope is to be a relational blessing with those whom the Lord brings us into fellowship so that the Kingdom of God may be put on display through our lives.
13. Pray with EMM for the regional retreat at the end of March. Pray that it would be a positive and impactful time together as a team.
14. Please pray for the Credentialing Commission as they meet today. Pray for discernment and encouragement for the commissioning and the pastors being interviewed.

15. The first semester ends on January 15th at Lancaster Mennonite School. Please pray for both teachers and students during the final week of this semester.
16. Please pray for the Bishop Board meeting so that the Holy Spirit will guide every conversation and decision, give them wisdom and unity, as they seek God's will for LMC.
17. Please pray for the STEP program so God will guide the facilitators and participants, strengthen their commitment, and use this program to form faithful, Spirit-led servants for His church.
