

## DISCLOSURE STATEMENT AND FBI CLEARANCE WAIVER FOR UNPAID/VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

Required by the Pennsylvania Child Protective Service Law  
23 Pa.C.S. § 6344.2 (relating to volunteers having contact with children)

I swear/affirm that I **AM NOT** required to obtain the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) Criminal History Clearance as I meet the following qualifications:

- (1) The position the prospective volunteer is applying for is unpaid.
- (2) The volunteer has been a resident of their State/Commonwealth during the entirety of the previous 10-year period.
- (3) The prospective volunteer swears or affirms here that he/she has not been convicted of an offense similar in nature to those crimes listed in section §6344(c) under the laws or former laws of the United States or one of its territories or possessions, another State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or a foreign nation, or under a former law of the State in which they reside.

### List of Reportable Offenses

1. Provision of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes (relating to crimes and offenses) or an equivalent crime under the laws or former laws of the United States or one of its territories or possessions, states, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or a foreign nations:

  - Section 3127 relating to indecent exposure
  - Section 2702 relating to aggravated assault
  - Section 4302 relating to incest
  - Section 2709.1 relating to stalking
  - Section 4303 relating to concealing death of a child

  - Section 4304 relating to endangering welfare of children
  - Section 2902 relating to unlawful restraint

  - Section 3122.1 relating to statutory sexual assault
  - Section 5903 (c) or (d) relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances
  - Section 3123 relating to involuntary deviate sexual intercourse
  - Section 6301 relating to corruption of minors
  - Section 3124.1 relating to sexual assault
  - Section 6312 relating to sexual abuse of children
  - Section 3125 relating to aggravated indecent assault
  - Section 3126 relating to indecent assault
2. An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64) known as “The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act,” committed within the preceeding five-year period.
3. A founded report within the preceeding five-year period in a statewide database maintained by the Department of Human Services.

I understand that, if I am arrested for or convicted of an offense listed above or am named as perpetrator in a founded or indicated report of child abuse, I must provide the event supervisor written notice not later than 72 hours after my arrest, conviction or notification. I understand that, if I willfully fail to disclose this information, I commit a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall be subject to discipline up to and including termination from or denial of a volunteer position.

I understand that if the event supervisor has a reasonable belief that I was arrested for or convicted of an offense listed above or that I was named as perpetrator in a founded or indicated report of child abuse, or I have provided written notice of a new arrest, conviction, or notification of substantiated child abuse as described above, they shall immediately require me to submit updated certifications.

I understand that the event supervisor is required to maintain a copy of my certifications.
